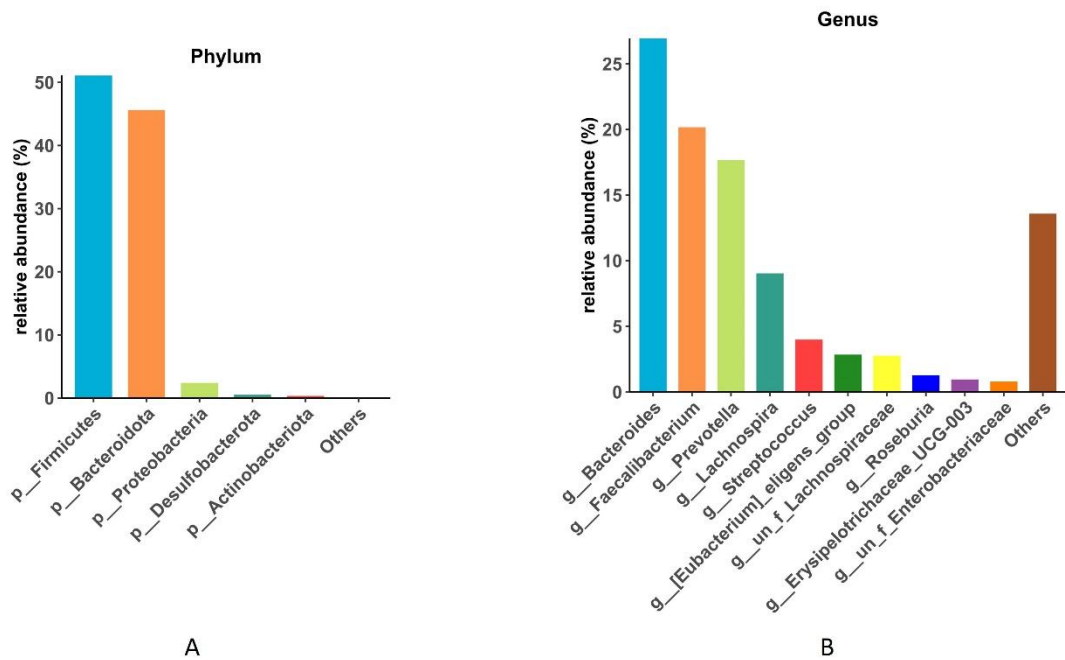


Gut Microbiota Analysis of Donor 1101

At the phylum level, the gut microbiota is dominated by Firmicutes and Bacteroidota. At the genus level, *Bacteroides*, *Faecalibacterium*, *Prevotella*, and *Lachnospira* are predominant. After FMT, the abundance of *Prevotellaceae_UCG-001* and *Lachnospiraceae_NK4A136* in mice is higher than in the model group, possibly due to the donor's higher abundance of *Prevotella* and *Lachnospira*.
