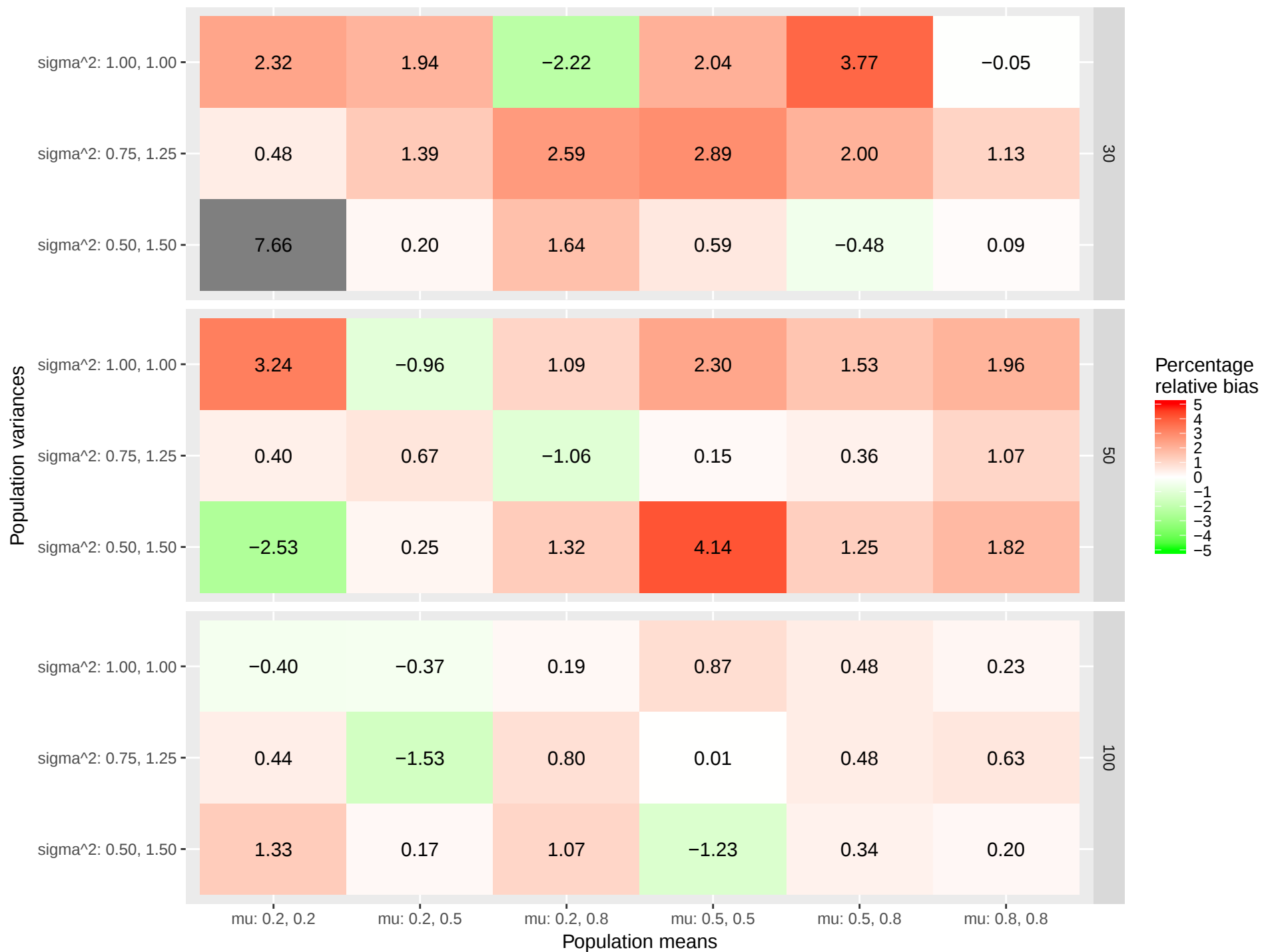
Relative Percentage Bias of the Second Parameter Estimates with the Assumption of Homogeneity of Variances for Multiple Treatment Studies



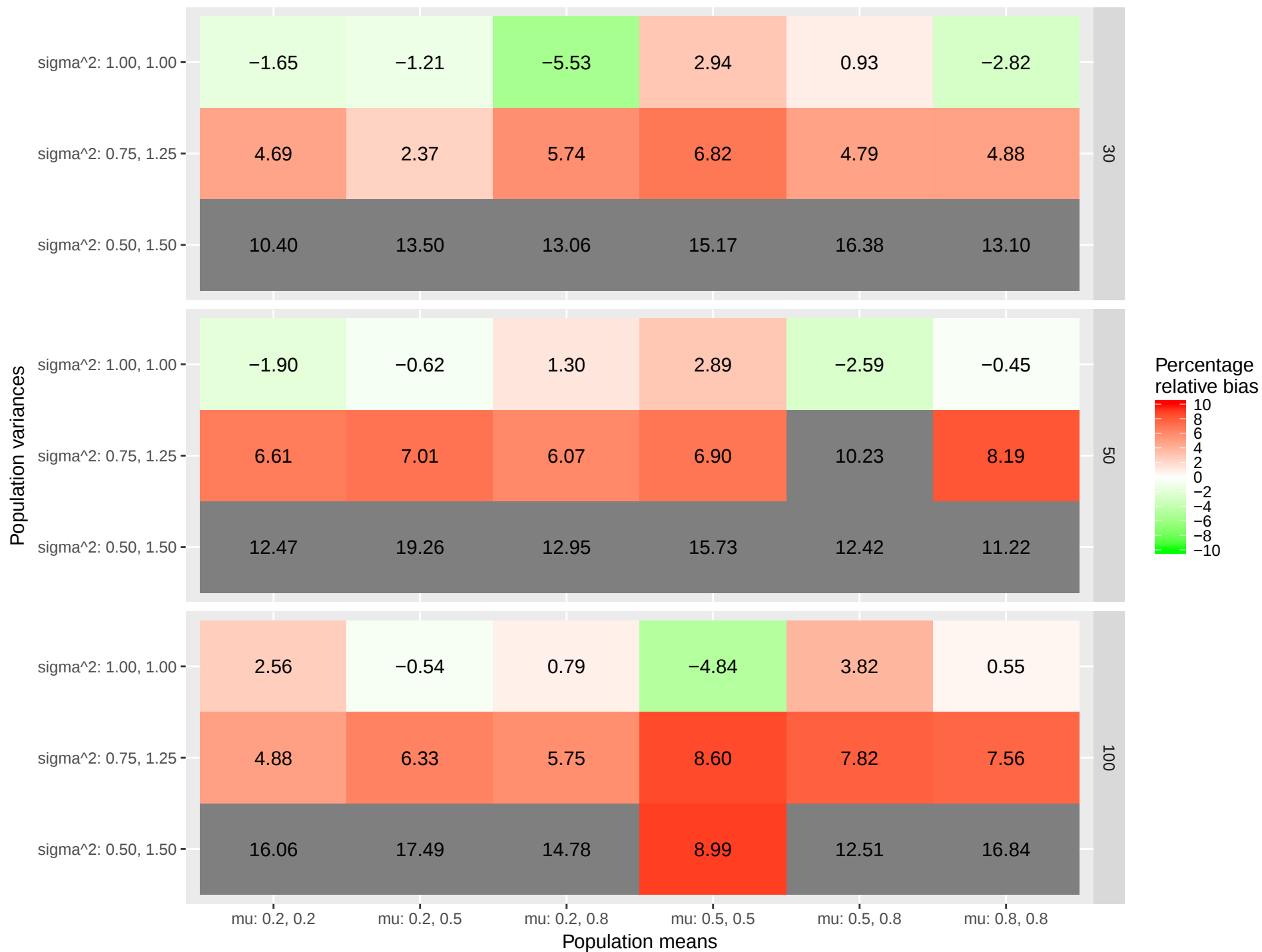
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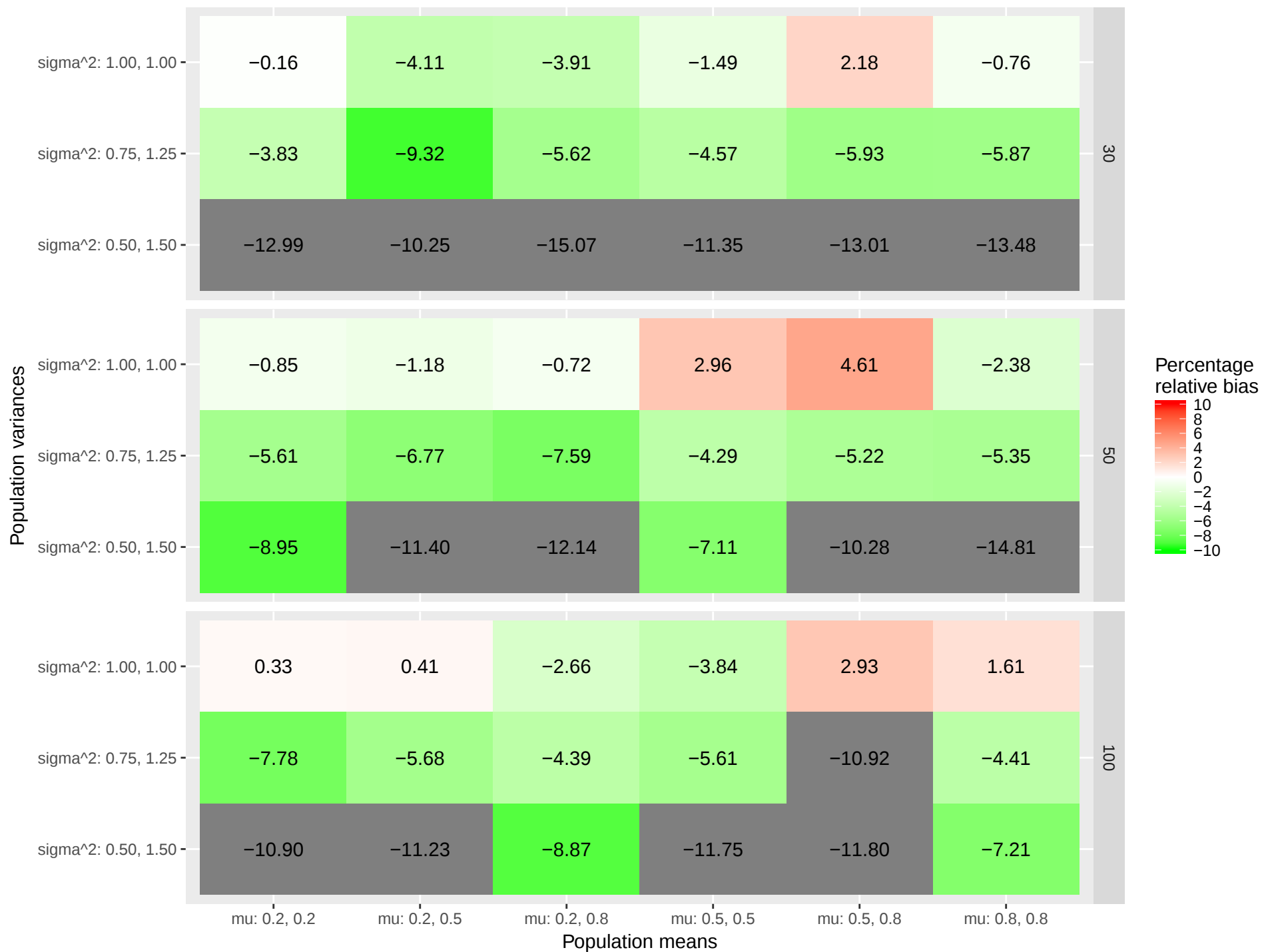
Relative Percentage Bias of the Second Parameter Estimates without the Assumption of Homogeneity of Variances for Multiple Treatment Studies

with the Assumption of Homogeneity of Variances for Multiple Treatment Studies



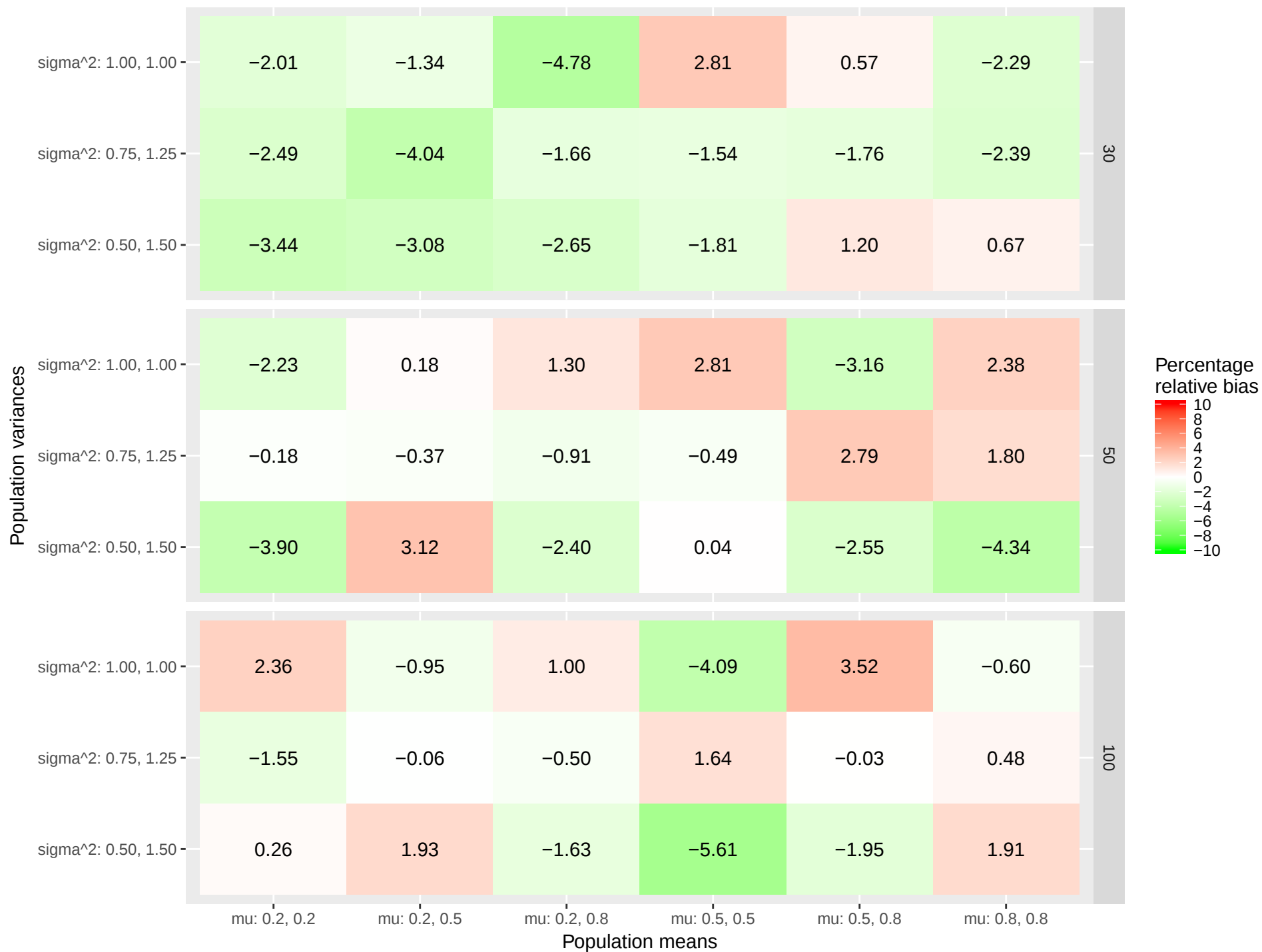
Relative Percentage Bias of the Second Estimated Standard Errors
