Bee species collected from northeastern Colorado. Bees were collected at 32 study sites in a five county region (Kit Carson, Logan, Phillips, Washington, and Yuma Counties) once per month for a 24-hour period using bowl and vane traps alongside hand-netting from June-September of 2013 and May-September of 2014. No morphospecies are included in this list. Bees were initially sorted and identified by Adrian Carper, Collin Schwantes, Mary Jane Howell, and Virginia Scott. Specimens of problematic genera were identified by Jason Gibbs (*Lasioglossum*), Zach Portman (*Perdita*), Terry Griswold (Megachilidae), and Karen Wright (*Melissodes*). Species with asterisks (*) are new records for the study region, and double asterisks (**) indicate new state records. Numbers in parentheses next to counties indicate the number of specimens of that species from that county. Historic species distribution data were obtained from Scott et al. 2011 and Goldstein and Scott 2015.
