

**Supplementary Material 1.** CTCAE v4.03 grading for pneumonitis and esophagitis.

<b>ADVERSE EVENT</b>	<b>Pneumonitis</b> <i>Definition: A disorder characterized by inflammation focally or diffusely affecting the lung parenchyma</i>	<b>Esophagitis</b> <i>Definition: A disorder characterized by inflammation of the esophageal wall.</i>
<b>Grade 1</b>	Asymptomatic; clinical or diagnostic observations only; intervention not indicated	Asymptomatic; clinical or diagnostic observations only; intervention not indicated
<b>Grade 2</b>	Symptomatic; medical intervention indicated; limiting instrumental ADL	Symptomatic; altered eating/swallowing; oral supplements indicated
<b>Grade 3</b>	Severe symptoms; limiting self-care ADL; oxygen indicated	Severely altered eating/swallowing; tube feeding, TPN or hospitalization indicated
<b>Grade 4</b>	Life-threatening respiratory compromise; urgent intervention indicated (e.g., tracheotomy or intubation)	Life-threatening consequences; urgent operative intervention indicated
<b>Grade 5</b>	Death	Death
