Just out of quarantine, the locals from Țăndărei want to leave the country: "People want to make money, there's no jobs, there's nothing "

As soon as they are out of quarantine, the locals from Ţăndărei make plans to go abroad to work as soon as possible. They told G4Media how difficult it was for them during this period, many of them having no source of income.

"I want to go to England, now on the 16th, if it is possible to fly." I have a little work there ", says one of the locals.

"I'm waiting for the planes to start and I'm gone, I'm not staying here anymore. I want to go to Germany, I have a contract there ", says a young man.

"Everyone wants to go abroad, to earn money too, there is no job here, nothing", laments another man in the locality.

"It wasn't good for us, we don't have any more money", complains a taxi driver.

"We want Romania to be free as it was!", A lady expresses her desire.

"It was like a prison. We thank God that he took us out, I prayed for that ", says another, emphasizing how he felt this period.

On the unpaved streets of lalomita, you see a horse grazing, but also cars worth tens of thousands of euros.

Read also Military Ordinance 11, issued by the Government. The quarantine measures in Jăndărei were lifted.

During the quarantine period, the people from Ţăndărei were confronted not only with the lack of money, but also with the fact that they did not have the opportunity to go to the doctor.

"I couldn't leave the city and I had problems with my elderly parents, they had to do medical check-ups in Fetești", says a lady.

The mayor of the city, Nicoleta Toma, said that many locals lost their jobs because they could not leave the city. "If those from abroad could come here, to work, those from Țăndărei could not go to work outside the city", she explained and drew attention to the need for help from the Government, on the economic side.

The city of Țăndărei entered total quarantine at the beginning of April. In the locality, there were 65 cases of infection with the new coronavirus and 10 deaths, 4 even in the city, the remaining 6 among those who were in other localities or abroad.

Alexandru Rafila: "After May 15, we can relax the measures. In areas like Țăndărei we will not do that "

Alexandru Rafila, the president of the Romanian Society of Microbiology, made several clarifications to Digi24 about the moment from which the restriction measures will be able to relax.

The army was sent to Ţăndărei to control the Roma who had returned from foreign countries and did not respect the rules of isolation. The city of Ialomiţa has become a real hotbed, and the authorities are afraid that the scenario in Suceava will not be repeated there as well. The Minister of Health, Nelu Tătaru, declared regarding the situation in Ţăndărei, that "in the context of the local situation, quarantines can be reached".

"Every place is evaluated. There are several small outbreaks. In the context of the local situation, quarantines can also be reached. The local authorities must do what is necessary to keep them in their homes ", said Nelu Tătaru regarding the case in Ialomiţa.

The County Committee for Emergency Situations approved on Thursday the request of the Public Health Directorate for the city of Ţăndărei to be quarantined, the proposal being sent to the Department for Emergency Situations, Ialomiţa Prefecture announced, quoted by Agerpres.

The decision was made due to the large number of cases of coronavirus infection in the last week and contacts of those in isolation.

"We had the meeting of the County Committee for Emergency Situations, where it was proposed to increase the number of law enforcement officers from Tăndărei. We approved 6 mixed police patrols plus gendarmes. They do not respect and have not respected from the beginning, not even the minimum recommendations, nor those at local, county or national level. Today I convened the committee again, at 12 o'clock, and I will propose the quarantine of Tăndărei city,

considering that there are already 4 dead people. If there are more than 3 cases with an epidemiological link between them, quarantine may be required. They came one by one (no. From abroad), not suddenly. They were taken into the records of DSP, we monitored very carefully, given the specifics of the locality, but if they did not understand to isolate themselves, we ended up in this situation ", said Toniţa Manea, prefect of Ialomiţa county, on România TV.

In Ialomiţa county, 37 cases of coronavirus infection have been confirmed, 208 people are in quarantine, and 2,429 in self-isolation and are monitored at home.

In one district of the city, called Strachina, four deaths were recorded and it was found that the locals did not comply with the measures imposed by the authorities, leaving the city without any stop. According to Rador, over 800 Roma from Ţăndărei returned from abroad in the last month and transmitted the new coronavirus to the community.

The HUGE fortune of an underworld clan from Jăndărei.

42 Romanians, members of a clan of thieves from Jândărei, were arrested following an action of the Spanish National Police. The gang of thieves is suspected of theft of over one million euros. Investigators say Romanians were very well organized, with older people training children and women.

Of these, 38 were detained in Spain, three in Romania and one in Portugal, following an investigation that lasted 15 months. Of the detainees, 17 are women.

"Early investigations show that gang members have been operating for a long time, since none of them have ever been hired, while their standard of living was high," the Spanish National Police said.

A man from Țăndărei, who became famous after performing live at the "Matei Balş" Hospital, says that he has been cured of COVID-19 and that he is preparing "a great feast, with pork and red wine" in ten days, when he hopes to be discharged. Eduard L. was followed by tens of thousands of people three days ago, when he sent on his social media account images in which he seemed in serious condition. The man was wearing a mask and was having difficulty breathing. He urged everyone to stay in their homes and pray to God. On Sunday, the man declared himself healed. He says he feels good and that the isolation is for the "sickest", instead, the strong like him will defeat the virus. Eduard announced to all his friends that when he leaves the hospital he will have a great time and advised them to wait for him with drinks and food.

The fights between Roma clans that scared Britain. The locals demanded the intervention of the Army

Scenes of extraordinary violence were captured in the British city of Sheffield. Dozens of people fought on the street, to the horror of the locals who are worried that the social distance measures are not respected. People say the perpetrators are Romanian, but the British authorities have not made public information about the nationality of those involved in the scandal.

The fight took place in Page Hall, one of the poorest areas of the British city of Sheffield, after the decline of the steel industry. According to the locals, the scandals have been going on here for some time among the Roma.
