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


FIGURE 4 | Association between ventral striatum activation and body mass index, mediated by insulin resistance (HOMA-IR) and leptin ($n = 18$).

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We have found a small error in **Figure 4** in our manuscript. Inadvertently, we presented the beta value for the total effect instead of the beta value for the direct effect there. As also written in the text and in **Table 3**, under the arrow that connects “Ventral Striatum Activity” with “Body Mass Index” it must read $c'1 = 0.31$ (without asterisks).
