In the original paper there were errors in **Figure 4** and in the text at page 7. **Figure 4** erroneously reported four asterisks, namely on top of T1 $\rho$  of putamen, T2 $\rho$  of midbrain, RAFF4 of midbrain, and ReHo of amygdala. The figure also did not report one asterisk on top of T1 $\rho$  of SNc. The correct version of **Figure 4** appears below.

In addition, the text at page 7 “Group differences between PD and controls were also observed for T2 $\rho$  in the amygdala ( $p = 0.033$ ) and thalamus ( $p = 0.08$ )” should read as “Group differences between PD and controls were also observed for T2 $\rho$  in the amygdala ( $p = 0.033$ ) and thalamus ( $p = 0.008$ )”.

The authors sincerely apologize for these errors that may cause confusion for the reader. These errors however do not change the interpretation of the results and the main message of the study in any way, because the interpretation was based on the correct results reported in the Supplementary Table.
