The corrected sentence appears below:

“Metabolomic analyses of SCFAs were carried out on the NUTRISS-INAF platform. Gas chromatography flame ionization detection (GC-FID) was used to profile plasma SCFA levels as previously described (1).”

The authors apologize for this error and state that this does not change the scientific conclusions of the article in any way. The original article has been updated.

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
